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## **WRITING STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT GOALS**

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### **Criteria**

- The baseline (current) achievement is included.
- The specific desired change is addressed.
- The time frame is specified (one year).
- The method of evaluating the desired change is specified.

### **Sample Student Achievement Goals**

- By June 2006, the percentage of students in grade one who meet grade-level standards in decoding will increase from 50% to 70% as measured by the BPST.
- By June 2006, the percentage of students in grades 9-12 who are proficient on the district writing rubric (3 or higher) will increase from 30% to 45%.
- By June 2006, the percentage of disadvantaged students who pass the state exit exam in math will increase from 33% to 45%.
- By June 2006, the gap between the percentage of LEP and Non-LEP students reaching proficient and advanced in English language arts on the California Standards Test will decrease by seven percentage points (from the current 25% difference), while both groups will increase their overall performance.
